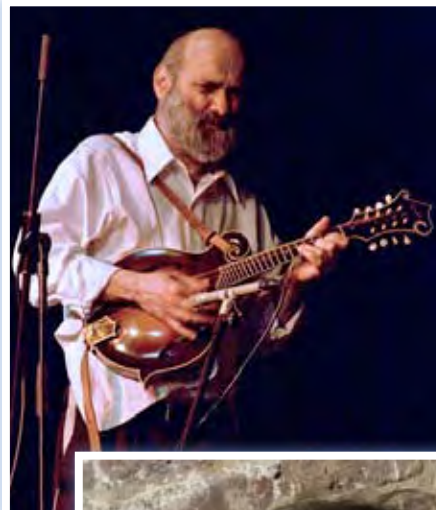

THE YEAR IN BRIEF

IN 2009, DESPITE THE UNSETTLED WEATHER AND THE UNSETTLING ECONOMY, we are happy to report that The Colonial has not only survived, but continued to prosper. This year we met or exceeded our budget goals and completed our 8th straight season of operation in the black. This season The Colonial presented 45 live and special events in addition to our feature movies. These special events included national touring artists in a variety of genres, an eight week children's series (now a staple of summer family entertainment in the North Country), emerging film makers, teen movie nights, artists documentaries, the BHC Summer Cultural Series and a host of community and school partnerships. In all, nearly 7,000 residents and visitors, including 1,200 young people, enjoyed a variety of cultural events at The Colonial.

This year also saw many improvements at the Theatre including the completion, on budget, of a significant construction project—a new patio, foundation repair and water diversion system. Initiated by a major gift from Edward and Nancy Roberts and supported by a coalition of other organizations and individuals (a big thank you goes to Vladimir Petkovich, AIA, for his pro bono architectural services and Gene Girdwood for donating his construction oversight), this new 1,400 square foot outdoor reception area represents a major facility improvement. It will help insure the long-term integrity of the facility by diverting water away from the building as well as providing a new venue for outdoor events, and concert intermissions. Additionally, in our continuing effort to enhance the audience experience at the Theatre, we have completed a Sound & Light booth at the rear of the auditorium. This will give our sound technician a much better perspective on live performances and improve the listening experience. Also, as the result of a very generous gift from Littleton Millwork, we replaced the damaged single pane casement windows on the façade of the building with replica insulated glass sashes. This is a significant energy saving improvement as well as a renovation in keeping with the historic character of the Theatre.

IN THE COMING YEAR we will act on the results of a recent energy audit and continue weatherizing and “greening” the Theatre by insulating the foundation and tightening up the building wherever possible with the goal of extending our fall season. We will also save energy by beginning to replace the incandescent lamps on the marquee and façade with energy efficient LED's. When complete this one improvement will save nearly 3500 kilowatt-hours per 1,000 hours of operation or 25% of our total electricity usage. In 2010 we intend to expand and improve our programming with particular attention to including more family oriented and informal musical events on the new patio.

THE COLONIAL IS EXTREMELY FORTUNATE to be located in a region that understands the importance of community, creating local opportunities, and nurturing new ideas and culture. The continued success of The Colonial is a testament to the power of these ideas in action.

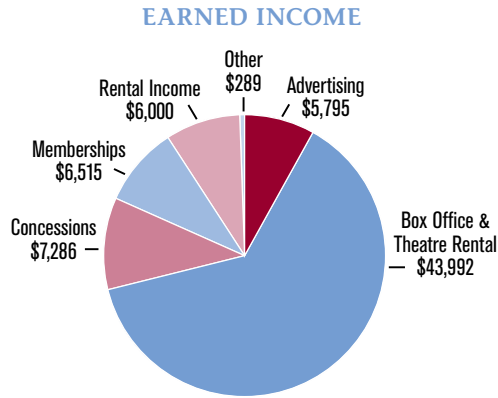

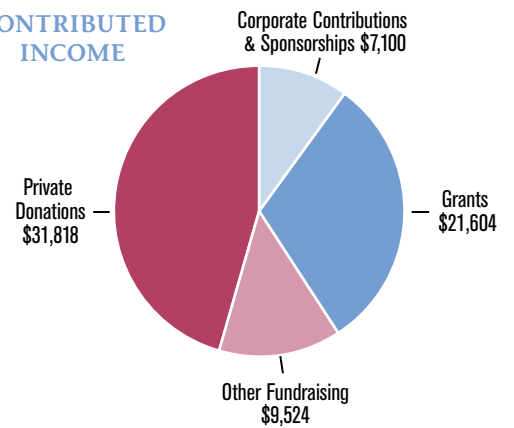

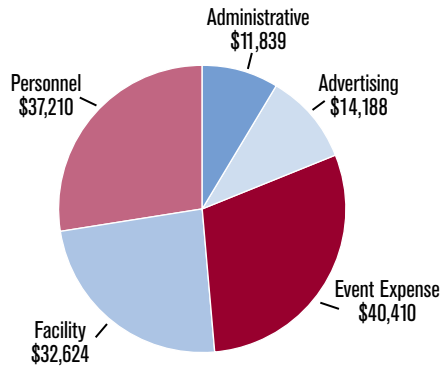

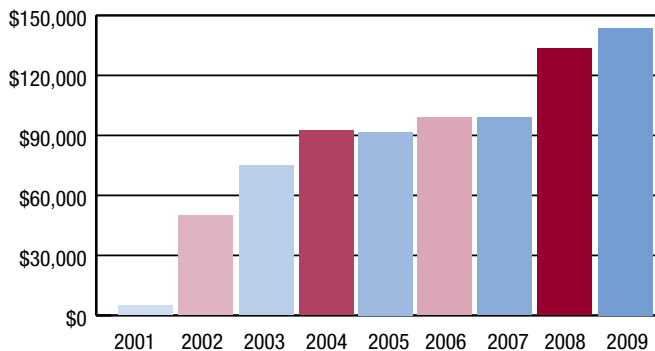
